



Building for the Future: The Belvedere Tiburon Library

Serving more than 17,500 residents on the Tiburon Peninsula, the Belvedere Tiburon Library has become a central part of the community. The demand for programming, meeting, technology, and collection space continues to grow. In response, the Library will soon undergo an exciting transformation that will greatly improve one of our community's most valuable and best-loved assets.

Facts

- The new space will add approximately 10,000 square feet new space, bringing the Belvedere Tiburon Library to about 20,500 total square feet.
- The Library will add space for an expanded children's area, a teen center, dedicated technology and creative spaces, new staff and volunteer spaces, Corner Books and café, and more.
- The project will cost approximately \$18 million, with no new taxes or bond measures requested from the community.
- Once construction begins, the project will take approximately 1.5 years to complete. The Library will remain open during most of this period.
- Dedicated marshland behind the library will not be affected by the new spaces.
